I have the honour to submit to you for presentation to Parliament my special report on investigation into the misuse of the vehicles and funds of the Ghana Ports and Harbours Authority (GPHA) by Hon. Alban S. K. Bagbin (MP), pursuant to Article 187 (8) of the 1992 Constitution of the Republic of Ghana and Section 18(2) of the Audit Service Act, 2000 (Act 584).

2. I found it necessary to conduct investigation into the matter in view of the huge loss caused to the Authority and the considerable public interest in the matter.
3. The report commenced in the year 2002 and has taken us over 18 months to complete. We examined the documents made available to us by the officials of GPHA, including internal audit reports, payment vouchers and receipts. We also received letters from Hon. Alban Bagbin which assisted us in reaching our conclusions.
4. I would like to thank my staff for their assistance in the preparation of this report and to the staff of GPHA for the assistance given to my staff during the investigation, and finally to Hon. Alban Bagbin for his cooperation.
